






## St. Pius BBQ

Every day my joy at responding to God's call to be a Catholic Sister only grows, and I can't imagine anything else I would rather do than to give my life completely to Him. THANK YOU for helping me give my "YES" to God! May each of you be strengthened and encouraged today by these words from God's heart to yours, from He who is powerful, who loves His children and who is able to do all things!


