NEWS REGARDING TFSA/ RIF's

1) TFSA contribution limit for 2015 has been increased from 5,500 to 10,000 in addition to any previous unused contribution room that you may have.

2) RIF min withdrawal %'s are changing downward and this affects all RIF's including those with the Knights of Columbus.

NEW FROM K OF C INSURANCE

1) VERY NEW: there are now more options for annuity settlements for lifetime income so that monthly or annual or other income will not run out until you and your wife have both died.

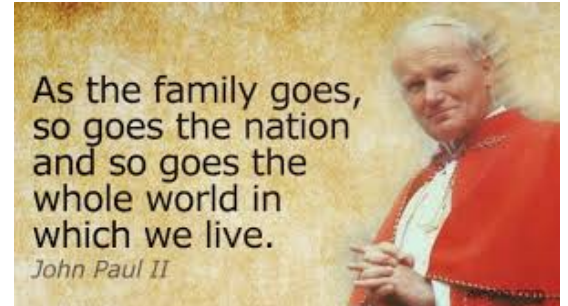
